**Student Immunizations**

**Code #453.2**

The Tri-County Area School District Board of Education believes that the best interests of all students can be served when all students have met Wisconsin's immunization requirements.

All students, including transfer students, admitted to the District shall present immunization records as required by law, or provide a waiver based on health, personal or religious reasons. Immunizations shall be required for measles, rubella, diphtheria, pertussis (whooping cough), poliomyelitis, tetanus, mumps, and hepatitis B, and any others required by the Department of Health and Family Services.

The school's designee shall be responsible for notification of parents/legal guardian of the immunization requirements, the right to immunization waiver, maintenance of immunization records, transfer of immunization records, in addition to notification of authorized officials of any non-compliant students and notification of possible exclusion from school for non-compliance.

Specific responsibilities of parents and the school shall be outlined by administrative rule, in addition to other special circumstances.
