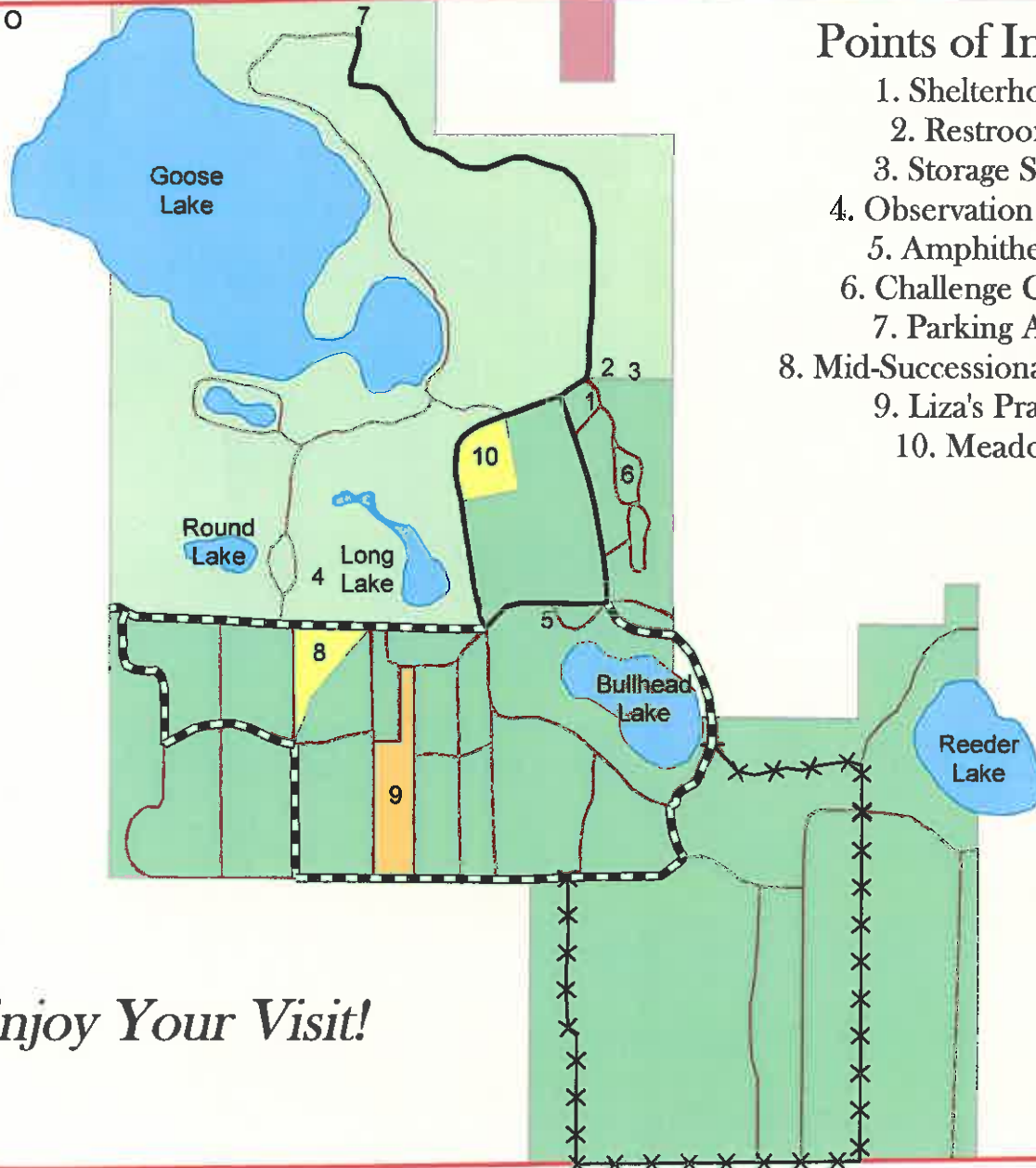

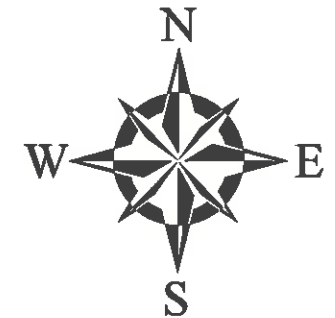

Tri-County School Forest Activity Trail System

This trail system was designed for your benefit. Whether hiking, biking, or skiing, we hope that you enjoy the beautiful landscape and gentle nature of the forest.

Three trails of various lengths have been developed. Each of the trails is an extension of the others, and each of the trails is marked with colored cross county skier arrows. Where trails intersect, trails are marked with two colored arrows. Feel free to take the trails of your choice and consider taking a copy of this map with you.

Timber View Trail (blue arrows)

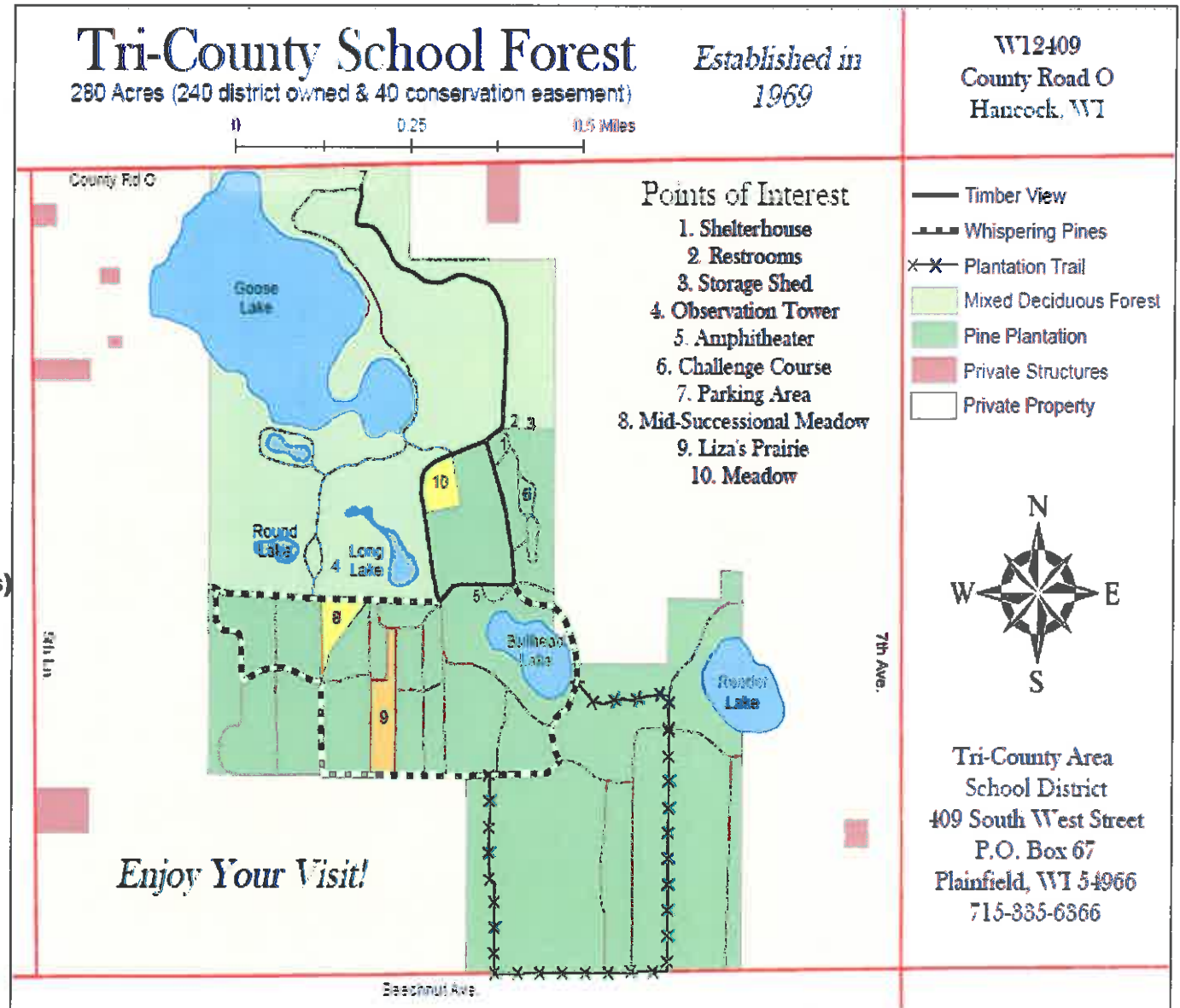
Being the shortest trail, 1.5 miles, this trail serves as a good warmup and provides access to the other marked trails.

Whispering Pines Trail (green arrows)

An extension of timber view trail, this trail is a bit more challenging. At 2.65 miles, it offers gentle slopes and a beautiful view of Bullhead Lake.

Plantation Trail (red arrows)

The longest marked trail in the school forest, at 3.80 miles, the plantation trail is an extension of the whispering pines trail. This trail takes users to the south end of the property and offers additional distance and slopes to those enjoying the stands of pines along the path.
