

**Closed Sessions**

**Code #173.00**

Tri-County Area School Board Meetings are open to the public unless Wisconsin Statutes exempt all or part of a meeting for a specified purpose. The Board may convene in closed session for any reason specified by Wisconsin Statutes.

Each closed session requires a motion and majority vote by roll call of the Board to be convened. Upon a motion to convene in closed session, the Board President or other presiding officer shall announce the nature of the business to be considered at the closed session and the specific exemption(s) under Wisconsin Statutes that authorizes the closed session.

No business may be taken up in a closed session except matters that relate to the subject(s) announced by the Board President or other presiding officer prior to the closed session. Except for individuals specifically invited or authorized by the Board to attend, closed meetings shall be closed to all but Board members.
