

Section 100: Board Operations

As part of a board member's oath of office, he or she pledges to faithfully discharge the duties of his or her office. Voting on motions and other actions brought before the Board is one of the duties of the office. Board members are expected to vote on all matters unless required to abstain due to a conflict of interest or other lawful reason.

A board member's decision to abstain shall be recorded and be considered acquiescence to the action taken by the majority. If a vote results in a tie due to abstention from one or more members the motion fails for lack of a majority. Proxy voting shall not be permitted.
