

**Physical Education**

**Code #341.05**

Physical education instruction shall be provided in the Tri-County Area School District in accordance with a developmental, sequential, comprehensive physical education curriculum taught by certified personnel for all pupils. The District believes that such a physical education program should help boys and girls to learn a broad variety of neuro-muscular skills and acquire the body of knowledge necessary to play and work in today's modern world. These learned attitudes and behaviors shall provide the basis for a desirable lifetime of fitness and healthy habits.

Instruction in grades PreK-6 shall be provided at least three times per week (unless waived by the Department of Public Instruction for class scheduling purposes). All pupils in grades 7-12 shall participate in the instructional program of physical education unless otherwise approved by the building principal to fulfill the requirements through special or adaptive physical education.

It is believed that the various body systems grow, develop and function best when they are exercised regularly and appropriately. Physical education students, programs, and instruction should be evaluated regularly to determine whether objectives are being met.

The District shall not discriminate in physical education programs or activities on the basis of race, color, creed, sex, national origin, handicap, disability, age, marital or parental status, political affiliation, or any other legally protected status.
