

Cooperative Education Programs

Code #341.23

The Tri-County Area School District Board of Education may approve the establishment of cooperative education programs which accommodate the needs of students who want to learn first hand the operations of an occupation or career. Specifically, these programs shall be designed to provide students with the opportunity to:

- Apply skills and knowledge acquired in school to a realistic job situation.
- Acquire additional skills and background not provided in a regular job setting.
- Develop the ability to communicate and work in harmony with people in a job situation.
- Gain a realistic understanding of the responsibilities of employment and of the standards of performance expected on the job.

Students must meet established prerequisites in order to participate in cooperative education programs.
