

Program for Children-At-Risk

Code #342.04

The Tri-County Area School District shall provide for the educational, emotional and physical needs of all pupils in a manner that allows them to reach their full potential. An At-Risk-Program is to be implemented that assists all children to learn to the best of their ability and at the rate that best meets their needs. The At-Risk Program shall address the issues and problems that children experience in their lives that significantly interfere with their learning and provide for a cooperative effort among school, home and community resources to meet their basic educational needs. The At-Risk Program shall have a systematic process of identifying at-risk children in grades PreK-12. There shall be an At-Risk-Coordinator and a Children-At-Risk Program team (committee) that shall be responsible for the development of an At-Risk Plan that identifies youth and the plan of service to the youth that fits the student's needs and interests. Annual statistics and data are to be kept on the At-Risk Program and reported as required to the Department of Public Instruction.
