

Graduation Requirements

Code #345.06

In order to graduate from the Tri-County Area School District, a student must complete at least 24.5 credits (22.5 credits for graduating classes of 2017 and prior) as set forth in Code #345.6 Rule.

All students are required by law to be enrolled in a class or other Board approved activity during each class period of each school day for all four (4) years of high school. Other Board approved activities include, but are not limited to attendance at: school-to-work programs; community service programs; technical college courses (youth options programs); and advanced placement courses.

Students may, however, be eligible for early graduation in accordance with established procedures.
