Procedures for Adult Student Tutor

The Tri-County Area School District Board of Education recognizes that valuable services for students can be made by community citizens as tutors. The Board encourages the use of tutors to help bridge communications between the District and the Tri-County area community.

Tutors may assist teachers under the supervision of a coordinator and principals by:

- tutoring students under the supervision of the classroom teacher;
- enabling the teacher to increase individual attention in the classroom; and
- providing enrichment experiences for students to supplement the regular educational program.

Tutors must receive approval from the building principal to participate in the delivery of any tutoring service.

Tutors will be covered under the District's liability insurance policy while performing services authorized by the school principal.

Tutors shall be expected to abide by all the school rules and regulations when performing their assigned responsibilities. An orientation to procedures and regulations shall be given by the building principals.

The building principals shall annually evaluate the tutorial program in their school and report the results to the District Administrator each May.
