Student Conduct on the School Bus Administrative Rule

Code #443.02AR 1

Bus Safety Rules

The following are minimum safety rules for Tri-County Area School District students to follow:

- Be careful in approaching bus stops; walk on left, toward oncoming traffic.
- Do not stand, or extend your head, arms, or hands out of the windows, or move about or attempt to leave or enter the bus while it is in motion.
- Remember that loud talking or laughing or creating unnecessary confusion diverts the driver's attention and may result in a serious accident.
- In leaving the bus, remain seated until it stops. If you cross the road, do so in front of the bus after making sure the highway is clear and after receiving the signal from the bus driver.
- In riding a different bus, a permission slip from parents of both households must be given to the office before noon. The secretary will then issue a change in bus pass.
- No students will be allowed to sit in the last two (2) rows of the bus unless the bus is filled to capacity. Those in the last two (2) rows will be required to move forward as soon as the first student(s) disembark.
