Code 447.00AR

Violations

Examples of behaviors which violate the Tri-County Area School District Policy #447.00 Student Discipline and which will result in disciplinary measures being taken include, but are not limited to, the following:

- ✓ Causing bodily harm to another person
- ✓ Use of profane and/or vulgar language
- ✓ Verbally threatening another person with physical harm
- ✓ Possession and/or use of tobacco products on the premises or when on field trips or other school-sponsored events (home or away)
- ✓ Possession, use, or being under the influence of alcohol or any illegal drug at school or any school-sponsored activity (home or away) or on a field trip
- ✓ Distribution of any illegal drug (or look-alike) at school or any school sponsored events (home or away)
- ✓ Huffing or inhaling substances not legally or medically prescribed
- ✓ Possession of and/or use of any electronic device including beepers, cellular phones, radios, laser pens or devices
- ✓ Causing false fire alarms and bomb threats
- ✓ Possession of any dangerous weapon as outlined under state and federal law and local and school regulations such as knives, brass knuckles, chains, stars, num-chucks, chemical spray, and other items that may be determined as dangerous, including firecrackers, smoke bombs, cherry bombs and other dangerous materials that will ignite
- ✓ Trespassing in unauthorized areas, disorderly conduct, using obscene gestures, willful disobedience such as refusal to follow school rules
- ✓ Disrespectful behavior
- ✓ Inappropriate displays of affection
- ✓ Disruptive behavior in the classroom hallways or any other area of the school or school grounds, disruptive behavior at school-sponsored events (home or away) or on field trips
- ✓ Lying
- ✓ Forging documents or notes and/or passes
- ✓ Slander and libel
- ✓ Ridicule or disgracing of another person

- ✓ Truancy
- ✓ Loitering in the school building or on school grounds
- ✓ Theft of school property or that of any person
- ✓ Vandalism of school property or of any person
- ✓ Harassment, including sexual harassment, of another person
- ✓ Any other illegal, unacceptable or inappropriate behavior
