

Professional Staff Development

Code #537.00

Professional staff development shall occur annually to keep teachers current on educational practices, changes in state and/or federal laws related to education, and Tri-County Area School District policies, rules, practices and procedures.

Staff development shall be planned by the Administration and teachers cooperatively and collaboratively. Staff development opportunities may be planned to include individuals on a one-to-one basis, small groups, grade levels, subject matter level, building levels, or the entire professional staff at one time.

The Principals shall be responsible, in collaboration with teachers, for the development of a yearly staff development plan. A yearly staff development plan and budget shall be forwarded to the Board for review and approval.

All staff development plans and activities shall be consistent with provisions of any calendar, bargaining agreement, Employee Handbook and legal requirements, as applicable.
