Minutes from Negotiations Meeting Held August 17, 2015

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson, Jim Cesar, @ 6:00 p.m. Committee Members present were: Jim Cesar, Mark Bacon, and Cindy Baumgartner. Peggy Buckholt was absent.

Others present; Anthony Marinack: District Administrator

Mark Bacon made a motion to move into closed session, pursuant to Section 19.82 (1) (c) and (e), Wisconsin Statutes to discuss 2015-2016 wage contracts with TCAEA; seconded by Cindy Baumgartner and motion carried on a roll call vote with all present voting yes.

Cindy Baumgartner made a motion at 6:25 p.m. to move back into open session. Mark Bacon seconded it; motion carried on a roll call with all present voting yes.

TCAEA arrived at 6:30 p.m. TCAEA members present Gary Knuth, Annette Carroll, Tina Krummell, Marjory Prescher, and Jessica Rettler. Initial proposals were exchanged. Jim Cesar pointed out that the two proposals looked the same. Gary Knuth agreed. Both the TCAEA and the negotiating team of the board were offering a 1.62% base salary increase. The committee will recommend the TCAEA offer to the full board on Tuesday. TCAEA thanked the board negotiation committee and left at 6:40 p.m.

Tony Marinack handed out information pertaining to the support staff. After some discussion, it was agreed upon to recommend a 1.62% base salary increase to the support staff.

A recommendation will be also for the Food Service and Building and Grounds supervisor a 1.62% salary increase.

Administration was discussed and the committee will recommend a 1.5% salary increase for the two principals and District Administrator.

Extra Curricular/Co-Curricular increase was discussed. It has been many years since we have given any raises to these individuals. It was agreed upon to give a 1.62% increase to the Co-Curricular schedule. This would be around \$1500.00 of new dollars needed over last year.

Teacher's steps and lanes increase was the last item of discussion. The board negotiating committee will be recommending that step and lane movements be approved for the 2015-2016 school year. Allowing only one lane movement per person, if applicable, this year.
