Position Title: **Stage Band**

Qualifications:

- Licensed music teacher, or music degree from a university and able to become certified as required by the Department of Public Instruction.
- Ability to relate with students and attract students to the program.
- Ability to coordinate the program with other programs in the school.
- Ability to accept directions from supervisors.
- Ability to follow work rules and procedures.
- Ability to be flexible to changing demands on personal time.
- Ability to accept personal criticism.

Immediate Supervisor: Building Principal or District Administrator

Position Function:

Be the immediate person responsible for promoting a stage band performance group, organizing a stage band group and work with students in the stage band as individuals and as a group to prepare them to perform before an audience yearly and/or as ensemble performers as the group may desire, if all instrumentation is available.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Provide the leadership to organize a yearly stage band performance group.
2. Preview and select music for the students in line with their abilities.
3. Announce for yearly Stage Band try-outs and select performers according to a fair and equitable manner.
4. Schedule rehearsal times and be present at all rehearsals to instruct and supervise.
5. Establish dates for yearly concerts before an audience and for solo ensemble competition.
6. Teach students in the many variations of jazz, blues, rock, and pop music, as well as in improvisation.
7. Teach basic music skills such as chords, scales etc. so those students can become more proficient at music and appreciate music to a greater degree.

Evaluation: Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with the provisions established under board policy on evaluation of employees. Evaluation of this job is done by the building principal.
