

Section 100: Board Operations

School Board Vacancies

Code #133.00

If any Tri-County Area School District Board Member resigns or otherwise vacates his/her position before the expiration of his/her term, the remaining Board will fill the position by appointment. The appointee must reside within apportioned area.

Positions on the Board of Education shall become vacant upon the:

1. Death of an incumbent.
2. Resignation of an incumbent.
3. Removal of an incumbent from office.
4. Absence of an incumbent from the District for a period exceeding sixty (60) days.
5. Conviction and sentencing of an incumbent by a court for treason or felony.
6. Occurrence of any other event as outlined by state law,

The process of appointment will be accomplished as soon as possible within sixty (60) days of the vacancy in accordance with established procedures and will be conducted in a manner consistent with Wisconsin's Open Meetings Law.
