

Public Notification of Board Meetings

Code #171.01

The Tri-County Area School District Board of Education recognizes the public is entitled to full and complete information regarding the affairs of the Board and is compatible with the conduct and transaction of Board business.

Notices of all meetings of the Board, whether held in open or closed session shall be posted in accordance with the provisions of the Wisconsin Open Meeting Law. No duly elected or appointed member of the Board will be excluded from any meeting of the Board. No business shall be transacted at any meeting of the Board unless proper public notice of the meeting has been given in such form as to reasonably apprise members of the public and the news media of the time, date, place and subject matter of the meeting, including subject matter intended for consideration at any contemplated closed session consistent with the Wisconsin Open Meeting Law.

In accordance with state law, public notice shall be given at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting. When, for good cause, 24 hours notice is impossible or impractical, shorter notice may be given, but not less than two hours notice may be given in advance of the meeting.
