

Special Board Meetings

Code #172.00

A special school board meeting shall be held upon written request of any Board member. The request must be filed with the Tri-County Area School District clerk, or in the clerk's absence, the District president shall notify, in writing, each Board member of the time and place of the special Board meeting at least twenty-four (24) hours before the meeting. A notice shall be delivered to each Board member personally or shall be left at the usual place of abode of a Board member or shall be mailed by first class mail to the usual place of abode of a Board member so as to arrive within twenty-four (24) hours before the special Board meeting, if possible. A special Board meeting may be held without prior notice if all Board members are present and consent, or if every Board member consents in writing even though he or she does not attend.

Public notice of the meeting shall be given in accordance with established procedures and Wisconsin Statutes. No business shall be transacted at the special Board meeting other than that specified in the notification thereof.
