

Board Committees

The Tri-County Area School District Board of Education maintains a committee structure to assist in the Board's decision making process. The President shall appoint (at the first meeting of the Board of Education after its organizational meeting, or as soon thereafter as possible) the following committees by mutual consent:

- Curriculum & Program Evaluation
- Negotiations
- Budget & Finance
- Athletics/Hot Lunch/Transportation
- Maintenance & Property
- Policy & Planning
- Personnel & Student Affairs

Committee membership will be reviewed annually at the time of reorganization. Consideration shall be given that the rotation of committee members should be such that no more than two (2) members of the same committee shall be up for re-election in the same year.

These committees will meet from time to time to consider matters in more specific detail and understanding than can normally be considered during the proceedings of a Board meeting. The committees have advisory powers and no authority other than recommendations to the Board at regular or special Board meetings.

Additional committees may be named on an ad hoc basis as required. Board members shall be appointed thereto by the President of the Board.

The President of the Board shall appoint the chairperson of each standing and each ad hoc committee.
