The Tri-County Area School District Curriculum & Program Evaluation Committee of the Board of Education shall consist of four members of the Board appointed to the Committee each year at or after the organizational meeting of the Board, by the President of the Board. The Tri-County Area School District Curriculum and Program Evaluation Committee shall work with the District Administrator and other appropriate personnel, as designated, to address the following issues, as appropriate:

1. Review all educational programs on a scheduled basis.
2. Review new educational program proposals and proposals for the discontinuance of existing programs.
3. Review the organization of instruction for the implementation of educational programs and courses in the various schools of the district.
4. Review all recommended textbooks.
5. Review curriculum materials to be included in the various courses of study, the standards to be achieved, and general teaching delivery systems that will be utilized during the course of instruction.
6. Determine that established policy relating to terms of the curriculum and methods of instruction are being complied with.

The Curriculum Committee shall make recommendations to the Board, as required, relative to the foregoing items.
