

**Athletics/Hot Lunch/Transportation Committee**

**Code #185.02**

The Tri-County Area School District Athletics/Hot Lunch/Transportation Committee of the Board of Education shall consist of four members of the Board appointed to the Committee each year, at or after the organizational meeting of the Board, by the President of the Board. The Tri-County Area School District Athletics/Hot Lunch/Transportation Committee shall work with the District Administrator and other appropriate personnel, as designated by the Board, to address the following issues, as appropriate:

1. Review, recommend, and/or delegate for appropriate action all bids or quotes relating to materials, supplies, capital equipment which are required for the operation of the Food Service Program or Athletic and Co-Curricular programs.
2. Recommend to the Personnel Committee, or to the Board as a Whole, needed changes in the Table of Organization in the Food Service or Athletic/Co-Curricular programs.
3. Review policies, procedures, and administrative rules for the Transportation Program, Food Service Program or Athletic/Co-Curricular Program and make appropriate recommendations.
4. Study and review operations relating to the District Food Service Program and present their findings and/or recommendations to the Board for appropriate action.
5. Study and review the District co-curricular and athletic activities and programs and present their findings and/or recommendations to the Board for action.
6. Act as hearing body for appeals from decisions of the administration regarding application of the co-curricular code to school students and, if necessary, present their findings and/or recommendations to the Board for action.
7. Initiate, review, and/or recommend policy regarding student transportation.
8. Review proposed bus routes with bus contractors.
9. As appropriate, act as a clearing house for complaints and suggested improvements regarding transportation services.
