

Negotiations Committee

The Tri-County Area School District Negotiations Committee of the Board of Education shall consist of four members of the Board appointed to the Committee each year at or after the organizational meeting of the Board, by the President of the Board. The duties of the Tri-County Area School District Negotiations Committee shall be to address the following issues, as appropriate:

1. Establish groundwork, guidelines, and direction for negotiations with all employee groups of the District.
2. Recommend to the Board that an attorney, or negotiator, be employed either to assist in drafting of contract language, advise the Board, serve on the negotiating committee, or serve as the Board's spokesperson at the bargaining sessions.
3. Meet with the Board in closed session to determine the parameters in which the Board will allow the Negotiations Committee to operate.
4. Make recommendations on salary, fringe benefits, and working conditions for all employees.
