The Board recognizes that advanced training for the District Administrator is important to the delivery of quality education and furthermore recognizes the responsibility of providing reimbursement for advanced training as outlined in the District Administrator's contract. Reimbursements such as, but not limited to, transportation (mileage), lodging, meals, registration/fees, etc. are paid for by the District.

The Board further realizes the importance of additional course work at the college or university level not only for re-certification but for professional advancement and in depth study and/or training. Consequently, reimbursement for college or university credits shall be made as per the District Administrator's Contract.
