Administrative Team

Code #230.00

The Tri-County Area School District Board of Education supports the concept and application of team management in the administration of the District. School administration demands a variety of talents which cannot be found in any one individual.

The District Administrator shall determine the structure and lead the administrative team. The team is responsible to the District Administrator who, in turn, is responsible to the Board.

The administrative team shall consist of the District Administrator, 7-12 grade principal, and Early Childhood-6 grade principal. In addition, the administrative team may include business administrators, assistant principals, a dean of students, department heads, program coordinators, counselors, food service, maintenance and other instructional leaders as may be deemed necessary to gain a broader decentralized and site-based management approach to decision making.

The administrative team shall make recommendations to the District Administrator on all matters pertaining to the operation of the District. Administrative team meetings shall be called by the District Administrator.
