

Development of Administrative Rules

Code #253.01

The Tri-County Area School District Board shall delegate to the District Administrator the function of specifying required actions and designing the detailed arrangements under which the schools shall be operated. These rules and these detailed arrangements shall constitute administrative rules governing the schools. The administrative rules must, in every respect, be consistent with the policies of the Board, statutory law, and case law. The Board reserves the right to review and veto administrative rules should they, in the Board's judgment, be inconsistent with statutory law, case law or with policies adopted by the Board.

In the development of administrative rules and regulations, the District Administrator shall include in the planning stage, whenever possible, employees who will be effected.

The District Administrator shall provide a copy of all administrative rules and regulations to members of the Board, with notations made concerning which policies they relate to.
