

Section 300: Instruction

Curriculum Development

Code #330.00

The Tri-County Area School District Board of Education has a responsibility for maintaining a minimum program of instruction guaranteed by state law, and for initiating improvements beyond that minimum. The Board shall approve academic standards for the District.

Professional staff members, under the direction and supervision of the District Administrator, shall be delegated the responsibility for proposing and developing Pre K-12 sequential curriculum plans, changes, and additions in the District. Assistance in curriculum development shall be obtained through Cooperative Education Service Agency 5 (CESA #5). In addition, the Wisconsin guides to curriculum planning for specific subject areas shall be followed and utilized in the District.

Curriculum materials developed in the District shall include the following:

1. A philosophy or rationale for the program or subject area;
2. The goals and objectives for each learning area;
3. The sequence of learning within and between grade levels
4. The alignment of learning objectives to the adopted academic standards.

Subject area offerings and any deletions or additions to the curriculum shall be reviewed and adopted by the Board before they are initiated into the program of instruction as needed
