

Curriculum Guides and Course Outlines

Code #331.00

Courses of study shall be submitted to and approved by the Tri-County Area School District Board of Education as recommended by the District Administrator in accordance with the District's policy relative to a goal-based curriculum process.

The District Administrator, Building Principals and/or designees are responsible for coordinating the development of Pre-K-12 curriculum guides within the Tri-County Area School District. Curriculum guides shall be planned, developed, and provided for all subject areas.

Curriculum guides and course outlines shall be designed to assist users in implementing the philosophy regarding the teaching of a course. Curriculum guides are to serve as a framework from which the teacher will develop individual lesson plans for day-to-day instruction within the classroom.

Curriculum guides are best developed by the staff and the people who use them. Principals and supervisors are responsible for monitoring instruction to make certain that course outlines are being followed in daily teaching. Sufficient latitude shall be permitted to provide motivation in the learning process through creativity, imagination, and ingenuity.

Curriculum guides will be regularly reviewed, revised, and approved according to the goal based curriculum model.

Copies of all approved course guides shall be available for review.
