

Section 300: Instruction

Health Education

Code #341.03

The Tri-County Area School District curriculum shall consist of Health Education as an integral part of a complete education for all students. The Health Education program shall provide students with skills needed to make rational decisions about health matters. Information gathered and knowledge attained in the health education program should help students focus on the factors needed to live active and productive lives. The Health Education curriculum shall consist of sequential instruction in grades PreK-12. Health Education may be taught in a number and variety of elective and required courses in grades PreK-12, on a number of selected topics, and on an integrated basis throughout the entire school curriculum.
