

## Section 300: Instruction

### Remedial Programs

Code #342.07

The Tri-County Area School District Board of Education recognizes that children do not learn at the same rate and same format of instruction. Therefore, the Board supports instruction and programs designed to address the remedial needs of students. The District will make reasonable effort to help ensure that each student learns the necessary skills, concepts and content of the course or subject area in which he/she is enrolled.

Remedial instruction programs/plans shall contain:

- A method of identifying students requiring remedial assistance and a list of those already identified;
- A method of assessing individual needs;
- Methods for providing remedial instruction;
- A method for evaluating the effectiveness of the program/plan;

Staff is expected to employ personalized instructional methods and utilize a variety of instructional formats and resources in providing remedial instruction.
