Parent conferences shall be scheduled twice each school year in the Tri-County Area School District. Every parent/guardian is invited to review the academic progress of his/her child. Parents/guardians shall be encouraged to confer with teachers at any time during the school year about the progress of their child. Such conferences shall be scheduled at the convenience of the parent/guardian and the teacher.

Parent-teacher conferences shall be held to:

- Supplement the report card and to serve as another means of reporting to parents/guardians;
- Promote good relations between the home and the school through an interpretation of the school's program; and
- Share information about a student's successes and accomplishments, problems and vital information.

Additional parent conferences may be held upon request of the student's parent/guardian, the student's teacher, counselor or principal.
