

Nondiscriminatory Testing

Code #346.01

The Tri-County Area School District Board of Education believes that students shall be protected against discriminatory testing practices. This includes students who have been referred for testing for disabilities. Procedures shall be established to ensure that test materials and other assessment devices to identify, classify and place students are selected and administered in a manner which is nondiscriminatory in its impact on students, regardless of sex, sexual orientation, race, national origin, ancestry, color, handicap, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital status or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. In that regard, procedures and tests shall be used which measure and evaluate equally well in all significant factors relating to the learning process, including, but not limited to consideration of sensory-motor, physical, socio-cultural and intellectual development, as well as adaptive behavior.
