**Use of Test Results**

**Code #346.02**

Public interest in and support of the District can be enhanced to the extent that the citizenry are apprised of the District's efforts. Therefore, it shall be the policy of the Tri-County Area School District Board of Education to report achievement test results through all appropriate media in accordance with state and federal requirements. Charts, tables and accompanying explanations of published test scores are to provide the public with information by grade, building and subject area. Additional information shall be reported as required by law. Names, or other identifying information, shall not be used when publishing test scores. Individual test results shall be the exclusive property of the District in which the child is enrolled and shall not be given to the public unless by written consent of student's parents/guardians, or student, if the student has reached the age of majority. Grades shall not be released to the public unless by written consent of the student's parents/guardians, or student, if the student has reached the age of majority.
