

Summer Opportunities Programs

Code #351.00

The Tri-County Area School District recognizes the need to give all children the opportunities to be successful. This program provides additional time to expand and maximize the educational opportunities of its students.

The District may offer students an opportunity to participate in summer school programs when there is enough student interest and available funds. All summer opportunities programs must have the annual approval of the Board and may be subject to Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction review. Courses offered in the summer opportunities program shall be based on needs and interests of students.

All children residing within the District boundaries during the summer session shall be considered resident students of the District for summer opportunities program purposes. Summer school shall be provided without cost to District residents, except for a nominal fee to cover the cost of materials used in class. Such fee shall be payable upon registration.

Children residing in other school districts and registering for attendance at summer school programs offered by the District may attend such programs that are in effect during the school year. Students enrolling in the summer program shall be expected to attend on a daily basis.

Students are expected to follow the same standards of conduct which apply to the regular school year. Those who engage in improper conduct will be removed from the summer school program.

Teachers and staff for the program may be recruited from within the District insofar as possible. The Board shall set salaries and approve staff hiring.

Summer opportunities programs shall be operated in accordance with state aid provisions outlined in the State Statutes.
