**Senior Class Trip**

**Code #352.01**

A Tri-County Area School District senior class trip may be endorsed by the Board of Education under the following conditions.

- Students must be in good standing.
- Any cost related to the trip shall be at the expense of the participants and/or senior class.
- At least four (4) chaperones (2 females and 2 males) must accompany the seniors on their senior class trip - two of which will be senior class advisors or teachers. The District will pay for two (2) substitute teachers for the release of two teachers.
- Trip must be taken prior to graduation.
- The trip will be limited to one (1) day and may be during regularly scheduled school hours.
- A trip location and itinerary (with date included) must be presented to the full board for their final approval at least two months prior to the trip.

An overnight trip will not be allowed.

Senior class funds may be used to pay for a senior class trip if previously approved by a majority of the senior class members.

Requests for senior class trips can be made each year and will be based upon the merits/behavior of the class over the four years of high school.

No precedent is established by allowing a senior class trip.
