Community Resources

Code #353.00

The Tri-County Area School District Board of Education recognizes that one of the greatest resources of the District is the people of the community who have special knowledge and particular talents to contribute to the school program. The Board, therefore, encourages the use of community resources and citizens to assist in furthering the educational program. Each principal should study the needs of his/her individual school, survey the resources available in the school community, weigh their probable usefulness, and present any plans that the principal may develop for using those community resources to the District Administrator for approval.

Use of community resource people in the District shall be under the direction of the building principals.

Staff members utilizing the services of resource persons shall ensure that these people are properly recognized for their contribution, either by means of students' letters or a note from the teacher.
