Student Tutor Program

Code #356.00

The Tri-County Area School Board of Education recognizes the importance of providing students with ample and equal opportunity to learn. A tutor program may be implemented at the appropriate grade levels to afford students learning assistance outside of and in addition to classroom instruction. The following criteria must apply:

- Only students that demonstrate a willingness to cooperate with the teacher
- A daily willingness to participate in classroom instruction
- A desire to learn attitude
- Completes and submits assignments to the teacher as requested
- Tries his/her best to complete examinations and quizzes.

Once a student is in the tutor program, he/she must comply with the same expectations as set for the classroom. Additionally, the student is expected to attend tutor sessions on time as scheduled, and bring necessary academic material and supplies to each session.

The classroom teacher, educational assistant (tutor), and building principal, shall make decisions regarding the assigning of students into the tutor program. This team may also remove students from the tutor program if the student fails to follow the guidelines of the tutor policy.

Parents of students entering the tutor program shall be notified of the tutor program rules. Parents will be notified of any problems occurring with their child in the tutor program that may result in their child's dismissal from the program.
