With this in mind, classroom, library, and computer lab print and non-print materials and resources used with and/or by students will be selected in accordance with the educational concepts to be derived from the materials. These materials should be deemed necessary to implement, enrich, and support the total educational program with due consideration given to the various points of view concerning the problems and issues of the day. Endeavors will be made to recognize the cultural, ethnic and religious backgrounds of the people and their contribution to history and American society.

The District shall not discriminate in selection and evaluation of instructional and library materials or media on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be handled in accordance with established procedures.
