Student organizations have an important place in the educational program of the Tri-County Area School District because, when properly organized and operated, they:

- Extend and reinforce the instructional program;
- Give students practice in democratic self-government;
- Build student morale and spirit for positive support for the school;
- Honor outstanding student achievement; and
- Provide wholesome social and recreational activities.

Student clubs shall be recognized as school organizations if they are authorized by the school administration, supervised by school personnel, composed completely of current student body members, hold the majority of meetings at school and establish aims that are educational and of District or community interest.
