

**Student Fundraising Activities**

**Code # 374.00**

No agent or person, or persons, shall be permitted to solicit any student or teacher for the purpose of distributing circulars, handbills, cards, or advertisements of any kind or make announcements of any nature, or take up contributions in any District building or on the premises, for any purpose whatsoever, except by approval from the Principal or District Administrator in accordance with the general policies of the Tri-County Area School District Board of Education.

Out-of-school fundraisers are to be limited in order to protect the community from excessive door-to-door solicitation.

The building Principal shall annually approve all out-of-school (door-to-door) fundraising activities. No child under the age of 12 may participate in any fundraising activity (door-to-door) unless he/she has written parental permission. Children under the age of nine must also be physically accompanied by a person 16 years of age or older when participating in fundraising activities.

All fundraising activities that involve the sale or distribution of products shall subject that product to the scrutiny of the building Principal at the time of the request for the activity.

It is expected that fundraising activities will be directed toward non-tax funded school projects or programs.
