

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian or student of legal age to complete official registration forms.

Resident students shall be admitted to the District without payment of tuition. Proof of residency, legal guardianship, or exchange student status may be required by the Administration.

The Tri-County Area School District reserves the right to determine grade and/or subject placement of all students entering the school system. Official registration forms must be completed prior to assignment by the Principal to a grade or schedule of classes.

Immunization records shall be provided as required by law.

The District shall not discriminate on the basis of a student's sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. This policy does not, however, prohibit the District from placing a student in a school, class, program or activity based on objective standards of individual performance or need. Discrimination complaints shall be handled in accordance with established procedures.
