

Section 400: Students

Admission of Foreign Exchange Students

Code #422.01

The Tri-County Area School District recognizes the positive cultural benefits to students, staff and the community in meeting students from other countries and in having foreign students as members of the student body.

Exchange students may attend school in the District (tuition free) under the following conditions:

1. The student attains the age of 16 prior to the start of the school year of enrollment.
2. The student is sufficiently proficient in English to satisfactorily profit from classroom instruction.
3. The student is placed with an active and responsible family that resides in the District.
4. The District's administration supports the student's admission.

The District reserves the right to limit foreign exchange student enrollments. Enrollment is currently limited to a maximum of two (2) exchange students in a school year, but this limit may be adjusted at the discretion of the District's administration.

Each enrollment request must be presented by a bona fide foreign exchange student organization approved by the District's administration.

This policy does not apply to foreign students residing in the District with their legal parent/guardian. Such students shall be subject to the same policies and procedures as other resident students.
