

Closed Campus

Code #434.02

Tri-County Area School District students are expected to be engaged in school-related or sponsored activities during the time designated by the Board as the school day. Students will not be permitted to leave the school or engage in non-school related activities without the permission of the Principal or his/her designee. Closed Campus is defined as being within the school facility and/or participation in activities expressly designated below:

- Classroom instruction
- Co-op classes and their related activities
- Direct and independent study within the school building:
 - Open labs
 - Resource centers
 - Library/IMC
- UW System and Technical College Classes (including transit time)
- Individualized Education Plan (IEP) developed for individual students
- Homebound instruction
- Field trips sponsored by a teacher(s), administrator(s), and/or other appropriate organizations
- Driver Education Vehicle Training
- At-Risk programs approved by the administration but implemented as off-site facilities
- Board approved release time for religious instruction.
- School-sponsored School-to-Work program

The designated lunch period is not an approved off campus activity unless expressly authorized by the Principal.
