

**Student Conduct**

**Code #443.00**

All student behavior should be based on respect and consideration for the rights of self and others. Students have a responsibility to know and follow the rules and regulations of the Tri-County Area School District. All students shall be expected to act in such fashion that their behavior will reflect favorably on the individual student and on the District.

Students shall conduct themselves in keeping with their level of maturity, acting with due regard for the supervisory authority vested by the Board in all district employees, for the educational purpose underlying all school activities, and for the widely shared use of school property. Students are expected to abide by any and all established codes of conduct, Board policies, conduct/behavior as outlined by the student handbook and as stated in rules established by building principals for each school.

The Principal is responsible for developing and administering reasonable rules and regulations for students outside the classroom, on school property or participating/attending in school activities and a classroom code of conduct in consultation with a committee of District residents consisting of parents, students, school board members, school administrators, teachers, pupil service professionals, and other District residents appointed by the Board. Such rules and regulations shall not conflict with Board policies, statutory law or case law.

All employees of the District shall share responsibility for supervising the behavior of students and for seeing that they meet the standards of conduct established by the Principal.

The District shall not discriminate in standards and rules of behavior, including student harassment, on the basis of sex, race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, handicap, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
