

Student Conduct on the School Bus

Code #443.02

The following are minimum rules for Tri-County Area School District students to follow:

1. Be on time for the bus. The driver does not have to wait.
2. Get seated immediately and stay seated until the bus reaches your stop. Bus seats can be assigned.
3. Keep body parts inside the bus. Throw nothing out of the bus.
4. Loud or rowdy behavior or profanity will not be allowed.
5. Be courteous at all times.
6. Your driver is allowed to make individual rules. You must obey your driver's rules.
7. Personal electronic devices may be used provided they do not impose unnecessary distraction and do not infringe on the privacy of other riders or the bus driver.
8. Keep the bus clean. No litter, graffiti, defacing the bus, etc. will be allowed.
9. The same code of conduct applies on the school bus as in the classroom.
