

Student Hazing

Code #443.07

Hazing is defined as an act whereby a student or students are required or forced against their will to perform activities as a pre-requisite to be a member of a school-recognized student organization or any other group that assembles on school property or whereby a student or students are required or forced to perform an act due to losing or winning a bet, contract or wager.

Hazing by the pupils attending the Tri-County Area School District is strictly forbidden regardless of the time or place it might occur.

Any violation of this rule shall result in the Administration taking disciplinary action against the violator(s) which may include suspension and/or expulsion from school.
