

Detentions

Code #447.02

School detentions may be employed by Tri-County Area School District school officials as a means of disciplining students for failure to comply with written school rules governing student conduct during school hours, at extra-curricular events (home or away), field trips, or any special school-sponsored school event.

Detentions are to be established in conformance with Board policy by the District Administrator and Principals.

Parents/guardians of students assigned detention are to be notified of the detention and reason for the detention in advance of the student serving the detention.

Students failing to serve detentions or refusing to serve detentions are subject to further disciplinary action of a progressive nature that may include suspension/expulsion from school. A record of assigned detentions shall be maintained in the student's cumulative file.
